In-classroom Groundwater Lesson

Groundwater is one of Tucson's most important resources. Our one-hour interactive groundwater lesson is available to area **3rd and 4th graders**. Through interaction with models, students learn how the groundwater system works and why it is important to us as water users in Tucson.



Sweetwater Wetlands Water Festivals

Field trips to the Sweetwater Wetlands provide **3rd and 4th grade students** with an exciting outdoor learning experience that ties together their water unit. Students rotate through four learning stations and experience the wetlands:

The Incredible Journey – Simulate water as it changes form and moves from one place to another within the water cycle.

Watershed - Learn how snowmelt and runoff contribute to local water supplies by interacting with a watershed model.

Water Conservation - Explore how technology has made water easier to access and waste, and also explore ways that technology can be used to save water.

Wetlands Tour - Explore the wetlands and discover how they provide food, water, and shelter for many different animals.
